Using your dictionary, grammar books, etc., first transliterate and then translate the following verses from the Bhagavad Gita.

निराशीर्यतचित्तात्मा त्यक्तसर्वपरिग्रहः ।

शारीरं केवलं कर्म कुर्वन्नाप्नोति किल्बिषम् ॥

nirāśīryatacittātmā tyaktasarvaparigrahaḥ ।
śārīraṁ kevalaṁ karma kurvannāpnoti kilbiṣam ॥

Without wishing for something else, restraining himself and his mind, abandoning all grasping, the one who performs action only with his body incurs no fault. (4.21)

यदृच्छालाभसन्तुष्टो द्वन्द्वातीतो विमत्सरः ।

समः सिद्धावसिद्धौ च कृत्वापि न निबध्यते ॥

yadṛcchālābhasantuṣṭo dvandvātīto vimatsaraḥ ।
samaḥ siddhāvasiddhau ca kṛtvāpi na nibadhyate ॥

Content with whatever comes his way, transcending all dualities, free from envy, impartial in success and failure, he not bound even though he acts. (4.22)
