**Using your dictionary, grammar books, etc., first transliterate and then translate the following verses from the Bhagavad Gita.**

तद् विद्धि प्रणिपातेन परिप्रश्नेन सेवया ।

tad viddhi praṇipātena paripraśnena sevayā ।

उपदेक्ष्यन्ति ते ज्ञानं ज्ञानिनस्तत्त्वदर्शिनः

upadekṣyanti te jñānaṁ jñāninastattvadarśinaḥ ॥

Know that it is because of your prostrations, your requests, and your service that the wise ones, the ones who really know the reality of things, will teach you. (4.34)

यज्ज्ञात्वा न पुनर्मोहमेवं यास्यसि पाण्डव ।

yajñātvā na punarmohamevaṁ yāsyasi pāṇḍava ।

येन भूतान्यशेषेण द्रक्ष्यस्यात्मन्यथो मयि ॥

yena bhūtānyaśeṣeṇa drakṣyasyātmanyatho mayi ॥

When you have gain this wisdom, Arjuna, you will not get deluded again. With that you will see that all beings, without exception, are in yourself and also in me. (4.35)
