A. Using books, dictionaries, etc., translate and provide the type of compound (dvandva, tatpurusha, karmadhāraya, or bahuvrīhi) of the following:

अपण्डित karmadhāraya, “not a scholar” (OR bahuvrīhi)

व्रीहियव dvandva, “rice and barley”

पादोदक tatpurusha, “water for the feet”

रामकृष्णौ dvandva, “Rama and Krishna”

स्थालपक्व bahuvrīhi, “cooked in a pot” (OR tatpurusha, “that which is cooked in a pot”)

अजावयः dvandva, “goats and sheep”

अतिदूर karmadhāraya, “exceedingly far”

वेदविद् bahuvrīhi, “knowing the Veda” (OR tatpurusha, “he who knows the Veda”)

पाणिपादं dvandva, “hand and foot”

चौरभय tatpurusha, “fear of a thief”

महापुरुष karmadhāraya, “great man”

जलक्रिडा tatpurusha, “sport in the water”

पितापुत्रौ dvandva, “father and son”

पादपद्म karmadharaya, “a foot lovely as a lotus”

वचस्पति tatpurusha, “lord of speech”

ग्रामगत bahuvrihi, “gone to the village”

सुकृत karmadharaya, “well-done” (OR bahuvrihi)

विद्याधन tatpurusha, “money from science”

नरसिंह karmadharya, “lion of a man”

शिवरक्षित bahuvrihi, “protected by Shiva” (OR tatpurusha)
