1. The first, fourth, sixth, and tenth classes of verbs are called by Whitney the “second or a-conjugation” type (others call these verbal classes “thematic”). Name and briefly describe what Whitney calls the six “classes of the first or non-a-conjugation” (a.k.a. the six “athematic” classes of verbs):

2. For the Sanskrit verb कृ, give the name of the verbal class under which it is categorized and give the nine forms of the conjugation for the present tense, active (parasmaipadi) voice:

3. For the Sanskrit verb भू, give the name of the verbal class under which it is categorized and provide the two forms of the present participle that is formed from this verbal root.
